As I sit down to write this letter, I do so with a heart full of gratitude for the love and support I have experienced in this church family for over a year now. It is this same love that I will now need to lean on as I share a developing health situation with you.

Over the past few weeks, I have been diagnosed with breast cancer. My specific diagnosis is an aggressive form of Invasive Ductal Carcinoma, Grade 3 and on Friday, October 11th, I will be having a bilateral mastectomy along with reconstructive surgery. My doctors expect me to be able to return to work after 3 weeks or so. My regular annual screening mammogram in February did not show anything suspicious.

As I begin this process of treatment and subsequent healing, I am putting my trust in God's plan and know that, through His grace, I can face this challenge with strength and faith. Thank you for being a part of my life and for your ongoing support. I will keep you updated on my journey and ask that you continue to keep me and my family, along with all those dealing with cancer, in your prayers.
